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### **DESCRIPTION OF POSITION:**

- Theologically aligned with the WEGO Statement of Faith
- Self-starter who can both create and implement vision
- A proven track record of personal disciple-making, leadership development, and team building
- A bachelor's degree or higher with a theological or mission focus is preferred
- Residency on Florida's Space Coast and international travel flexibility required

### **RESPONSIBILITIES**

#### **Church Partnerships**

- Build, manage, and oversee long-term local church partnerships in the United States that serve our ministries and local church partners abroad
- Work with local pastors to serve, resource, equip, and mobilize their church body within our ministries and the communities we serve
- Effectively communicate opportunities, expectations, and ministry updates with our local church partners
- Ensure all mobilization activities are in line with WEGO philosophy and strategy.

#### **Group Trips**

- Plan, coordinate, oversee all WEGO group trips
- Work with Executive Director and local staff to ensure all trips are aligned with current field needs and ministry philosophy and strategy.

- Execute all trip functions including logistics, field ministry, budget, applications, and team training.
- Lead group trips or manage trip leaders

### **Missionary Care**

- Recruit, shepherd, coach, and oversee all missionary activity through pastoral care and accountability.
- Work with sending church to provide missionaries with spiritual and emotional support
- Work with missionaries to develop and execute their long-term goals and ministry strategy that promote WEGO philosophy and long-term vision.
